

Doxa Price List – 2020

Doxa updates its prices on an annual basis, commits to keeping them consistent throughout the year, and will provide you with an accurate invoice prior to your trip. Unless something unexpected happens on your trip, the price on your invoice will be the price of your trip. We hope these practices can help you to effectively budget on your end and provide transparency as to trip costs.

Construction Prices

- \$5,258 – materials to build a house alongside a local family (excludes cement and rebar)
- \$530 – site leveled, cement form boards laid, and cement slab poured in advance.
 - If your group is interested in a shorter trip and/or not doing concrete work, this is a good option to consider.
- \$275 – cement, rebar, and wire ties for your group to pour the slab.
- \$100 – site leveled and concrete form boards laid in advance.
 - If your group wants to do the concrete work, but not spend a day leveling the site this is a good option to consider.
- \$50 – rental of a Doxa tool kit to use throughout your trip.
 - Groups can also bring their own tool kits. Checkout the Tool Kit Inventory document on the Trip Resources webpage for guidance on what is included.
 - Even with this tool kit, each participant should bring their own hammer, nail pouch, and work gloves.
- \$1,750 – Doxa leader is with your group for the entire duration of your trip.
 - May be required for first time groups or may be provided at group request.

Lodging Prices

- Hogar de los Niños
 - \$12 per person, per night – new building on the 5th and 6th floors
 - \$11 per person, per night – old building
 - \$8 per person – dinner prepared by the orphanage for your group
 - Groups must also purchase dinner for all orphanage people, which adds about \$300 onto the total per dinner.
- Unidos por Siempre
 - \$8 per person, per night
 - \$8 per person – dinner prepared by the orphanage for your group
- El Rancho
 - \$12 per person, per night
 - \$8 per person – dinner prepared by the orphanage for your group
- \$65 – baño placed at your lodging site or worksite (includes 1 cleaning during your trip).
 - Portable bathrooms are recommended for groups that are larger than the capacity of bathrooms at their site.
- \$100 – security guard for the duration of your trip. Typically used for large groups who stay at Hogar de los Niños or El Rancho locations.

- Note: lodging prices include all utilities to be used by the group (i.e. drinking water, electricity, garbage disposal, propane, etc.)

Doxa Pickup Trucks

- \$125 per day – use of a Doxa pickup truck (US and Mexico insurance included).
